

Memorials are suggested to: St. Anthony Park Lutheran Church, Lutheran World Relief, and The Osteogenesis Imperfecta Foundation Lila Theressa Lee Storaasli, age 103 and 11 months, died peacefully on August 19, 2023 after a short stay in Duluth. She was born September 14, 1919 and raised on a dairy farm on a bluff above Ferryville, WI prior to electricity and plumbing. She graduated from Viroqua High School and studied a year at Gale College before attending Fairview Nursing School, from which she received her RN.

Lila married Olaf Storaasli in 1942 and they spent their lives devoted to each other, their faith, service to others, and their family. They lived in Saskatoon, Canada for fifteen years before settling in St. Paul, where Olaf was a professor at Luther Seminary, a community to which Lila contributed much: she participated in a Faculty Wives Book Group for almost 50 years, until she was over 100, and often opened their home to seminary faculty and students. Lila resumed her nursing career at Fairview and Lyngblomsten. She provided a home for international students from Holland, Turkey and India.

Lila and Olaf spent sabbatical leaves in Edinburgh, Claremont, CA, Rome, Papua New Guinea and Richmond, VA. They also enjoyed many world travels together, including a 3-month marathon tent camping trip with all four kids visiting 13 European countries.

A 63 year member of St. Anthony Park Lutheran Church, Lila sang in choir, tied perfect knots in quilting, knit prayer shawls, prayed for and got acquainted with several prayer partner children, nourished relationships with shut-ins through Care Team Ministry, attended Bible Study and WELCA and encouraged support for World Missions and anything focused on sharing God's love.

Lila loved and attended symphony and opera concerts over many years, well into her 90s. She always set a beautiful table, loved her grandchildren and their kids, she was known by some as a baby whisperer. She was an intrepid cribbage player and usually had enough Special K Bars to share and send home. She learned

to pump gas at age 86, flew in her grandson's experimental aircraft at age 92 and drove until she was 100. She loved spending summers at Ottertail Lake and swam in the lake 'til age 102.

Lila is survived by sister Edith Sandwick, children Olaf (Barbara) Storaasli, Carolyn Nestingen, Faith Hutin (Arnie Rydman), Elizabeth Storaasli (Mark Knutson); 11 grandchildren: Ole Storaasli (Andi Balloun), Paul Storaasli (Sabrina Almeida), Andrew Nestingen (Karen Baker), Peder Nestingen (Sarah Horstmann), Jacob Ole (Sonja) Nestingen, Erica Ullsvik (Matt Jahnke), Stephanie Hutin (Florencio Zavala), Claire Hutin (Tamer Harpke), Marit Knutson (Haakon Nelson), Anna Knutson, Karin Britta Knutson (Patrick Hughes); and 19 great grandchildren
